Internship Information:

- The UC Internship is a ministry of the church of Christ University Center and is under the oversight of the elders of the Stillwater church of Christ.
 - UC Interns will be under the direct oversight of the UC Director of Campus Ministry and will work within a staff environment consisting of the Director, the Campus Minister Graduate Apprenticeship, and the UC staff.
- The UC Internship program is available to students who have met the following requirements:
 - Have shown a consistent model of spiritual maturity, personal integrity, and Christ-like leadership.
 - Have exhibited an involved and leadership-oriented role in campus ministry.
- Compensation
 - The UC Internship Position is a paid position with the understanding that interns will work a minimum of 10 hours per week in campus ministry. Interns will receive a monthly stipend at the end of each month in the gross income amount of \$360.00 (less required taxes).
 - Interns will also receive a professional expenses package to help offset the cost of sharing time, meals and fellowship with students.
- Dates of Internship
 - The UC Internship position will report for orientation and training beginning one week before the Fall 2021 semester and will continue through the end of the Spring 2022 semester. (typically the first week of May)
 - Interns may also be required to participate in zoom meetings as well as completing assignments, readings and Mental Health First Aid training during the preceding summer.

- **TRANSCRIPT** - Please include a current collegiate transcript (or pdf/jpeg format) from Oklahoma State University upon submission.
- **REFERENCE LETTERS** - Please include 2 letters of reference which include one from each of the following areas. These can be emailed as well.
 - A ministry leader / minister from your home congregation
 - A reference source of your choice.

Please provide no less than a 1/2 page response to EACH of the following questions:

- Describe your religious background and your conversion to Christianity.
- Describe your involvement in campus ministry and/or leadership in ministry opportunities. How has your spiritual walk grown and changed since beginning college? What lessons and challenges have you experienced?
- How would explain the gospel of Jesus Christ to someone?
- How would you describe the role of the UC internship? What is it's purpose? What do you expect to gain from the internship? What do you expect to share with others through it's role?
- What is a Scripture that you think defines Christian ministry for you?
- Describe your past college work experience in high school and college. What skills have you acquired through these experiences? What challenges have you encountered? What are your long-term career goals? (what do you want to be when you grow up?)
